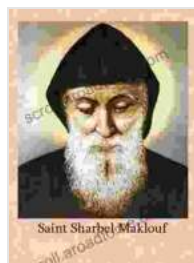


Saint Sharbel: Saint Brother Ada

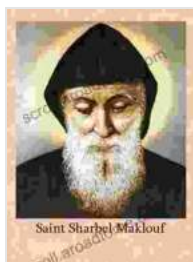

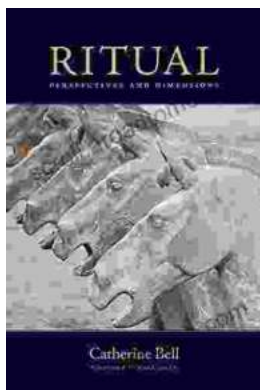

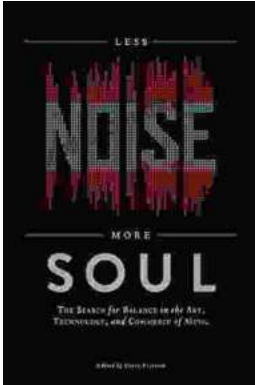
