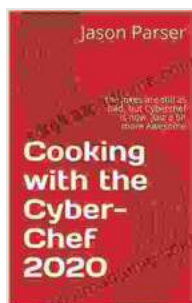

As I mentioned before, the jokes in this book are terrible. But that's what makes them so funny. Here are a few of my favorites:

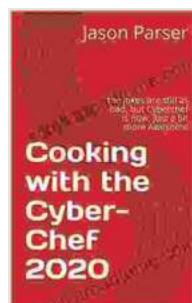
- Why did the scarecrow win an award? Because he was outstanding in his field!

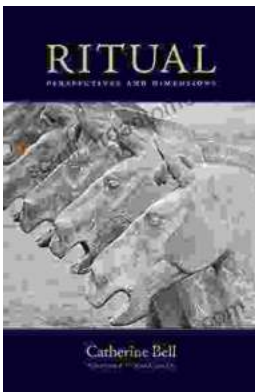

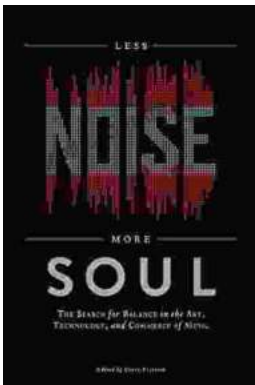
